
Newspaper Seed Starter Pots


Use newspaper 17" by 11"

1. Fold paper in half (short end to short end), crease well

2. Fold paper in half again (short end to short end), crease well




3. Fold paper in half once again (short end to short end), crease well




4. Unfold last fold




5. Rotate paper so open side is on top





6. Fold right bottom edge


7. Repeat step 6 on the left side




8. Flip paper on back and repeat steps 6 and 7 to renforce the folds


9. Repeat steps 3 and 4 on this side of the paper to renforce the center fold

10. Fold right flap up so it is vertical (like a wall), leave left side horizontal (like the floor)



11. Put pointer finger between half of the vertical pages, all the way down to the middle point






15. Repeat steps 11


12. Press down and flatten triangle in front


13. Flip entire paper over 14. Take rectangle on



right and fold horizontal (similar to step 10)













23. Fold bottom triangle up, crease, and unfold


and hold it down with a paper clip

24. Fold top flap down 25. Flip entire paper over and fold bottom triangle up again, and unfold










26. Fold top flap down and hold it down with a paper clip
