Praying in the Spirit and Inspiration of St. Dominic deGuzman (1170-1221) Feast Day: August 8

Gathering and Centering:

<u>Leader 1</u>: Called and empowered in God's Holy Spirit we pause from the

busyness of this day to focus our efforts and attune ourselves to the work of this committee. We pray in the spirit and inspiration of St. Dominic.

Dominican Saint: St. Dominic de Guzman

<u>Leader 2</u>: Dominic was born into a family of privilege and educated in Spain where he attended university for ten years, studying the arts and theology. Education and learning, kindness and charity, were centerpieces of his life. While Dominic journeyed from place to place he prayed and preached speaking always to or of God.

Dominic is described as a joyful friar, founder of an Order of Preachers, who taught his followers to praise, to bless, to preach. Ministry of the Word following prayer and study was a value he imparted by his example. He taught his friars the art of reaching the hearts of others by animating them with a love of humankind. Once, after delivering a stirring sermon, he was asked in what book he had studied it. "In none," he answered, "but that of love."

Dominic founded a community of nuns in Prouille, France in 1206. These nine women who were converted from the false teachings of the Albigensian heresy supported the work of the preaching friars by their life of contemplative prayer.
